Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) Application for certificates of public convenience and necessity (certificates) for Norfolk County, the County of Elgin and the County of Middlesex Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2017-0108

In its Decision and Order, issued October 17, 2019, the OEB granted certificates to Enbridge Gas' and EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership (ENGLP) pertaining to Norfolk County, the Municipality of Bayham, the Municipality of Central Elgin, the Township of Malahide, and the Municipality of Thames Centre. The Decision and Order was based, in part, on a joint submission filed by Enbridge Gas, ENGLP and OEB staff.

On October 31, 2019, Enbridge Gas filed a letter on behalf of itself and ENGLP. Through the letter, Enbridge Gas and ENGLP each proposed two minor corrections to the Decision and Order.

With respect to the orders listed on pages 6 and 7 of the Decision and Order, Enbridge Gas proposed the following:

2. The certificates of public convenience and necessity attached as Schedules A1 to A5 of this Decision and Order cancel and supersede the following prior Enbridge Gas Inc. certificate authorizations:

a. Those parts of F.B.C. 259 related to the County of Elgin, <u>the former County of Norfolk</u>, <u>the former Town of Delhi, the former Town of Port Dover, the former Town of Simcoe</u>, the former Township of Charlotteville, the former Township of Houghton, the former Township of Middleton except for those parts in Oxford County, the former Township of North Dorchester, the former Township of North Walsingham, the former Township of South Walsingham, those <u>former</u> parts of the Township of Southwold within the Municipality of Central Elgin, the former Townships of Townsend and Woodhouse except those parts lying in the Haldimand County, the former Township of Westminster, the former Township of Windham, the former Township of Yarmouth

except those parts within the City of St. Thomas, <u>the former Village of Dorchester</u>, the <u>former Village of Port Rowan</u>, and the former Village of Port Stanley-except those parts within the Township of Southwold and the former Village of Waterford.

With respect to certificate issued to it for the Municipality of Thames Centre, ENGLP proposed the following:

Concession 2 – Those portions of Lots 1 and 2 lying south of Highway 401, and those parts 2793 Bradley Avenue in the eastern portion of Lot 1 lying north of Highway 401 identified as 2793 Bradley Avenue and 3073 Westchester Bourne.

On November 4, 2019, OEB staff filed a letter with the OEB in support of the utilities' requests.

Pursuant to its powers under Rule 41.02 of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the OEB may at any time, without notice or a hearing of any kind, correct a typographical error, error of calculation or similar error made in its orders or decisions. The OEB considers the errors identified by the utilities, and confirmed by OEB staff, to be typographical.

The OEB accepts the requests made by Enbridge Gas and ENGLP. The corrections to the Decision and Order can be found on pages 7 and 8, and in ENGLP's certificate for the Municipality of Thames Centre at Schedule B5. The Decision is not otherwise changed in any way.

The OEB's letter of direction dated October 17, 2019 directed Enbridge Gas to serve a copy of the Decision and Order on the clerks of Norfolk County, the County of Elgin, the County of Middlesex, the Municipality of Bayham, the Municipality of Central Elgin, the Township of Malahide, and the Municipality of Thames Centre. Enbridge Gas is directed to serve a copy of the revised Decision and Order instead.
