n its original application, OPG estimated a 2020 IPI of 1.8%¹ to estimate the proposed 2020 hydroelectric payment amounts and corresponding customer bill impacts. OPG also stated:

If the OEB's published index values include different annual percentage changes in either of the GDP-IPI FDD or the Ontario AWE, OPG will update this Application and the proposed 2020 HPA accordingly.²

The OEB issued its IPI for electricity distributors for 2020 on October 31, 2019, with a value of 2.0%.³ OEB staff has calculated the 2020 IPI for OPG to be 1.8% as seen in the table below. The calculation is the same as for electricity distributors, with the exception of the labour and non-labour weights. As approved in EB-2016-0152, the weights for OPG's prescribed hydroelectric assets are 12% labour and 88% non-labour.
