BRACEBRIDE GENERATION LTD.

Application for an Electricity Generation Licence Amendment

Decision and Order

Bracebridge Generation Ltd. (Bracebridge) filed an application on August 23, 2019 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), to amend electricity generation licence EG-2003-0120. Bracebridge also requested concurrent cancellation of Elliott Falls Waterpower Corporation's (EFWC) electricity generation licence EG-2003-0132, pursuant to section 77(5) of the OEB Act.

Following the amalgamation of Bracebridge and EFWC, Bracebridge requested that the OEB amend Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence to include the ownership and operation of the Elliott Falls Generation Station with an installed capacity 0.7 MW, located in the City of Kawartha Lakes, Ontario. Elliott Falls Generation Station is currently listed in Schedule 1 of EFWC's electricity generation licence EG-2003-0132. There are no other changes requested to the licence. All other provisions remain the same.

As the amalgamated entity continues as Bracebridge and there are no other facilities listed in EFWC's electricity generation licence EG-2003-0132, the applicant requested this licence to be cancelled.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- Schedule 1 of Bracebridge Generation Ltd.'s electricity generation licence EG-2003-0120 is amended to add Elliott Falls Generation Station. The amended licence is attached to this Decision and Order.
- 2. Elliott Falls Waterpower Corporation's electricity generation licence EG-2003-0132 is cancelled.
