**Re: Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario (FRPO) - Request for intervenor status  
Enbridge Gas Inc. - Owen Sound Reinforcement Leave to Construct & Rate M17  
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2019-0183**

This letter is in response to FRPO's request for intervenor status and cost award eligibility in the above-referenced application. FRPO's request was received by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on November 2, 2019 after the deadline for filing such requests had closed.

FRPO states that it is a "...leading advocate for quality rental housing, representing over 800 private owners and managers who supply over 350,000 rental suites across the province. Our members believe strongly that the rental-housing sector is best served by a competitive marketplace that offers choice and affordability in the provision of energy services." FRPO states that its interest in this proceeding relates to rate impacts arising from the application and noted that it was granted intervenor status and cost eligibility in the original rate M17 application, EB-2018-0244.

Enbridge Gas Inc. did not object to FRPO's request.

The OEB is satisfied that FRPO has a “substantial interest” in this proceeding within the meaning of Rule 22.02 of the OEB’s *Rules of Practice and Procedure* and is approved as an intervenor. FRPO shall accept the record of the proceeding to this point. FRPO is also eligible to apply for cost awards under the OEB’s *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.
