# Enbridge Gas Inc.

Application for approval to construct a natural gas pipeline and associated facilities in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent and the Towns of Lakeshore and Tecumseh

#### PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2

### November 13, 2019

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 9, 2019 under section 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, (*Act) for approval to construct approximately 64 kilometres of natural gas pipeline and ancillary facilities in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent and the Towns of Lakeshore and Tecumseh. Enbridge Gas also applied to the OEB under section 97 of the Act for approval of the form of agreement it will offer to landowners to use their land for routing or construction of the proposed pipeline and ancillary facilities.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on September 13, 2019. Each of Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) and the Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario (FRPO) applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility. No objection was received from Enbridge Gas.

In Procedural Order No. 1, issued on October 11, 2019, Energy Probe and FRPO were approved as intervenors and the OEB made provision for the filing of interrogatories, interrogatory responses and submissions by parties.

On November 11, 2019 FRPO filed a letter stating that, in its view, the record of this case is not sufficient to determine if the level of expenditure forecasted is warranted. FRPO requested additional discovery on the application by means of a technical conference. The OEB is considering this request and seeks submissions from parties on the merits of FRPO's request. The OEB will therefore suspend the dates for submissions on the application set out in Procedural Order No. 1.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The dates for submissions and reply submissions set out in Procedural Order No. 1 are suspended until further notice.
- 2. OEB staff, Enbridge Gas and intervenors shall file written submissions on the merits of FRPO's request for additional discovery with the OEB and serve them on all parties by **November 14, 2019**.
- 3. FRPO may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on all parties by **November 15, 2019**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2019-0172**, be made in searchable/unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <a href="https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/">https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</a>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.
