Re: Imperial Oil Limited Application Number EB-2019-007 for Leave to Construct – Waterdown to Finch Project (the "Project")

Section 6.1.3 of the Board's Practice Direction on Confidential Filings permits accepting a Declaration and Undertaking from such persons in appropriate cases. We respectfully submit that it is crucial for the counsel and engineer of Toronto's choice to have access to the Confidential Documents, making this an appropriate case.

For the above-noted individuals, we have taken the liberty of striking through the reference in paragraph 2 of the Form of Declaration and Undertaking relating to (non)-employee status.
