Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2019-0059 proceeding, the application by Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for approval of electricity distribution rate adjustment effective January 1, 2020.
