Hydro One Networks Inc. – Barrie Area Transmission Upgrade Project Independent Electricity System Operator – Intervention Request

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) is in receipt of the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB) Notice of Application and is writing to request intervenor status in the above noted proceeding.

The IESO is responsible for maintaining and administering the Ontario wholesale electricity markets, and directing the operation and maintaining reliability of the IESO-controlled grid.
