## Burlington Hydro Inc.

## Application for electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2020

## PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 December 2, 2019

Burlington Hydro Inc. (Burlington Hydro) filed an incentive rate-setting mechanism application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on October 10, 2019 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998* seeking approval for changes to its electricity distribution rates to be effective May 1, 2020.

A Notice of Hearing was issued on November 4, 2019. Each of Vulnerable Consumers Coalition (VECC), Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) and School Energy Coalition (SEC) applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility.

No objection to the intervention requests was received from Burlington Hydro.

VECC, Energy Probe and SEC are approved as intervenors. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this Procedural Order. VECC, Energy Probe and SEC are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* and only in relation to Burlington Hydro's request for incremental capital and to discontinue the "Incremental Capital Project 1 (2019)" rate rider.

At this time, provision is being made for written interrogatories. Parties should consult Rules 26 and 27 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure* regarding required naming and numbering conventions and other matters related to interrogatories.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. OEB staff and intervenors shall request any relevant information and documentation from Burlington Hydro that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on Burlington Hydro and all other parties by December 20, 2019.
- 2. Burlington Hydro shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on all intervenors by January 17, 2020.
- 3. Written submissions by OEB staff and intervenors shall be filed with the OEB and served on all other parties by January 31, 2020.
- 4. Burlington Hydro shall file a written reply submission with the OEB, and serve it on all intervenors by February 14, 2020.

All materials filed with the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2019-0023, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <a href="https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice">https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice</a>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <a href="http://www.oeb.ca/Industry">http://www.oeb.ca/Industry</a>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
