Re: Ontario Energy Board Application EB-2019-0007
Imperial Oil – Leave to Construct – Waterdown to Finch (the “Project”)

We write with respect to the above-noted matter. The Huron-Wendat Nation (“HWN”) has been engaged for many months in discussions with Imperial Oil Ltd. (“Imperial”) regarding what accommodation measures are required to address the Project’s impacts and potential impacts on the HWN’s rights. While it is the HWN’s view that some progress has been made, the parties have not yet finalized an agreement as to the accommodation measures Imperial will commit to in order to avoid, mitigate or compensate for the impacts the Project has had and will continue to have on the HWN’s inherent and treaty rights.

In order to provide a further opportunity for the parties to work together to agree to appropriate accommodation measures, the HWN requests an extension of the Intervenor’s deadline for filing comments on the Project application to **December 20, 2019**.
