RE: Consultation to Review Natural Gas Supply Plans – Draft OEB Staff Report

Ontario Energy Board File No. EB-2019-0137

Today the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued for comment a *Draft OEB Staff Report to the OEB: Consultation to Review Natural Gas Supply Plans* (draft OEB Staff Report). The draft OEB Staff Report sets out OEB staff's initial assessment of Enbridge Gas Inc.'s (Enbridge) five-year natural gas supply plans.

# **Background**

On July 25, 2019, the OEB initiated a consultation to review Enbridge's five-year gas supply plans in keeping with the gas supply plan assessment process contemplated in the OEB's <u>Report of the Board: Framework for the Assessment of Distributor Gas Supply Plans</u> (Gas Supply Framework)<sup>1</sup>. In the <u>July 25, 2019 letter</u>, the OEB stated that it would include an additional step to the process outlined in the Gas Supply Framework to provide Enbridge and stakeholders further opportunity for input. Specifically, the OEB included the opportunity for Enbridge and stakeholders to comment on a draft OEB Staff Report that outlines OEB staff's initial assessment of Enbridge's five-year gas supply plans against the guiding principles of the Gas Supply Framework.

#### **Invitation to Comment and Cost Awards**

The OEB invites Enbridge and stakeholders to submit written comments on the draft OEB Staff Report by **January 17, 2020.** 

The eligible hours per participant for stakeholder's written comments on the draft OEB Staff Report will be up to 10 hours. An updated list of the activities for which cost

As set out in the Gas Supply Framework, following consideration of the final OEB Staff Report, the OEB may determine that a proceeding is required to address specific issues highlighted by the final OEB Staff Report.
