DECISION AND ORDER

Planet Canada Inc., doing business as PC Ontario Energy filed a complete application on October 18, 2019 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence. The licence would allow the applicant to retail electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the applicant's technical capability, financial viability and conduct, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity retailer licence to Planet Canada Inc., doing business as PC Ontario Energy for a period of two years. As a new entrant to the market, the applicant should use the next two years to demonstrate that it is a reliable participant in the electricity market.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for an electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
