Business activities:


Cedarline Greenhouses is a 16-acre, poly-covered bell pepper greenhouse. To take advantage of production efficiencies and current market trends, plans are to increase the acreage by 30 acres over the next 5 years.

Another key project to promote growth in the company is the installation of the 5.4 MW cogeneration plant currently in the commissioning stage.

Currently, Cedarline Greenhouses is a bulk supplier of peppers which is not a long-term financially sustainable model. The investments outlined above will position the company to successfully implement a production/marketing strategy which will capture added value from the market place. The biggest opportunity will be meeting the growing consumer trend of value added packaging of greenhouse vegetables.

Corporate organization:

The following table outlines the corporate & ownership structure of Cedarline Greenhouses and its affiliated/associated entities:



Greg Devries is the president of Cedarline Greenhouses and his wife's name is Jennifer. Charlie Devries is Greg's father and his wife's name is Jennie.

Affiliated and associated companies:

Truly Green Farms (2333281 Ont Ltd) is a subsidiary company. It is a 67.5 acre glass covered tomato greenhouse operation. Plans are to build the last of 4 phases (another 22.5 acres) in 2021 for production in 2022. A unique component of the Truly Green greenhouses is a partnership with the adjoining ethanol plant that provides waste heat and CO2 to the greenhouses.
