**Re: Algoma Power Inc. (“API”) Application for 2020 Distribution Rates (EB-2019-0019)  
Typographical Error in Tariff**

Subsequent to the Board’s issuance of a Final Rate Order in EB-2019-0019 on December 5, 2019, API has discovered a typographical error related to a rate rider for its Street Lighting rate class. The “Rate Rider for Disposition of Group 2 Deferral/Variance Accounts (2020)” is listed as a \$/kW rate rider, but should in fact be listed as \$/kWh.

This error stems from the original May 17, 2019 application, in which the rate rider was calculated using the kWh billing determinant (consistent with API’s past practice for rate riders for this class), but the proposed tariff incorrectly showed \$/kW. Throughout the hearing process, the DVA Continuity model, Bill Impact model, and all written evidence correctly reflected a \$/kWh rate rider, while the proposed 2020 tariff continued to show \$/kW. Unfortunately, this discrepancy was not discovered prior to the final rate order stage of the proceeding.

Since there is no concern with the calculations underlying the rate rider, API respectfully requests that the Board correct the typographical error on API’s 2020 Tariff, pursuant to Section 41.02 of its *Rules of Practice and Procedure*.
