DECISION AND ORDER

TransAlta (SC) Inc. on behalf of TransAlta (SC) LP (TransAlta) filed an application on November 11, 2019 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence renewal. The licence would allow the applicant to continue retailing electricity to large volume industrial customers directly connected to TransAlta's co-generation facility located in Sarnia, Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing the conduct, technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity retailer licence to TransAlta (SC) Inc. on behalf of TransAlta (SC) LP.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for an electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
