We have many naturalists and birding groups visit our farm to see: bobolinks, meadowlarks (eastern), Savannah Sparrows, Cattle egrets, trumpeter swans, indigo buntings. We also have many snakes, frogs, and blanding turtles. Many of these at at species risk.
