The Ontario Ministry of Energy, Northern Development and Mines (ENDM) has completed its review of Imperial Oil's Indigenous consultation report for the Waterdown to Finch Pipeline Project. This letter is to notify you that it is our understanding that there are no outstanding concerns from Indigenous communities that are known to ENDM at this time. As a result, the ministry has no concerns with the sufficiency of the consultation to date. ENDM is of the opinion that the procedural aspects of consultation undertaken by Imperial Oil to date for the purposes of the Ontario Energy Board's Leave to Construct approval process for the Waterdown to Finch Pipeline Project is satisfactory.
