Energy+ Inc. – 2020 IRM Application – Cost Awards**

Dear Ms. Long:

Energy+ Inc. (“Energy+”) has reviewed the cost claims submitted to Energy+ by School Energy Coalition (“SEC”), and Consumers Council of Canada (“CCC”). Vulnerable Energy Consumer Coalition (“VECC”) did not submit a cost claim directly to Energy+.

Energy+ would draw to the Board’s attention the following: (i) the cost claim submitted by SEC was a combined cost claim and did not include a split of the costs between Energy+ and Brantford Power Inc. (“BPI”); (ii) VECC’s cost claim was submitted with a reference to BPI’s EB-2019-0022 and did not contain a split of costs, if any, between Energy+ and BPI; and (iii) CCC submitted separate cost claims for E+ and BPI.

As a result of the varying approach to the cost claims submitted by the Intervenor, Energy+ is not able to assess the amount of overall costs to be allocated to Energy+. Energy+ would propose that the Board request that SEC, and VECC if applicable, prepare a separate cost claim for each of Energy+ and BPI that reflects the effort required for each of the applicants, taking into consideration the various elements of the ICM application process.
