**Re: Elexicon Energy Inc. (Elexicon Energy)
Amalgamation of Veridian Connections Inc. and Whitby Hydro Electric
Corporation Combined Distribution System Plan
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2018-0236**

On December 20, 2018, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued its Decision and Order granting approval for the amalgamation of Veridian Connections Inc. and Whitby Hydro Electric Corporation, and, among other things, ordered that the amalgamated entity (now Elexicon Energy) file a combined Distribution System Plan (DSP) with the OEB.

This letter acknowledges receipt, on January 31, 2020, of the letter from Elexicon Energy requesting confirmation from the OEB with regard to the filing date for the combined DSP.

In its letter, Elexicon Energy noted that it identified a discrepancy with regard to the date on which it is to file its combined DSP. Elexicon Energy highlighted that page 17 of the OEB's Decision and Order stated that the combined DSP was to be filed within 24 months of the Decision – implying that the combined DSP is to be filed by December 20, 2020. In contrast, on page 21 of the Decision and Order, it was stated that the combined DSP was to be filed with the OEB within 24 months of the closing of the amalgamation transaction – implying a later date (i.e., March 31, 2021) by which the combined DSP was to be filed.

The Decision and Order mistakenly contained conflicting dates as to when the combined DSP was to be filed. The OEB confirms that Elexicon Energy shall file the combined

DSP no later than March 31, 2021 (i.e., 24 months from the closing of the amalgamation transaction). Pursuant to Rule 41.02 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, the OEB has therefore revised its findings on page 17 of the Decision and Order as follows:

Findings

With respect to the potential ICM applications, the OEB has found that its policies outlined in the Handbook apply to this amalgamation transaction. LDC Mergeco may apply for an ICM during the deferral period, however, a combined DSP must be filed with the OEB within 24 months ~~of this Decision~~ of the closing of the proposed transactions.
