Application for Electricity Generation Licence Amendment

DECISION AND ORDER

Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) filed an application on November 26, 2019 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (OEB Act) to amend its electricity generation licence EG-2003-0104.

OPG requested an amendment to remove from Schedule 1 of its licence the following electricity generation facilities that have been decommissioned: Lambton Generating Station, Nanticoke Generating Station, Unit 1 of Thunder Bay Generating Station, BIC Wind Turbine, Pickering Wind Turbine, and Smokey Falls 1 Generating Station. In its application, OPG provided approvals, timelines and reasons for decommissioning these generation facilities.

OPG also requested an amendment to reflect the name change of one facility from Indian Chute Generating Station to Chute Generating Station. Additionally, OPG requested some minor corrections to river systems and spelling of facility names.

This Decision and Order is being issued by Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act.

Based on the evidence, the OEB finds that it is appropriate to grant the requested amendment to Schedule 1 of OPG licence EG-2003-0104.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Schedule 1 of Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s electricity generator licence EG-2003-0104 is amended as requested to delete the names of the six decommissioned generation facilities, to correct river systems and to amend the facility name.

The amended licence is attached to this Decision and Order.
