Dear members of the Energy Board and Mr. Yurek,
I'm a citizen of Hamilton who has a young family. I am very concerned about the climate crisis, and the impact it will have on my children and the generations that come after them. I am writing to urge you to consider the climate crisis in your review of the Enbridge fracked gas pipeline. In 2018 the world's climate scientists warned us that we must cut greenhouse gas emissions by at least half by 2030, a warning that many appear not to have heard or believe. There are deep connections between the climate crisis and the fossil fuel industry, and despite their assertions that we need their products, we cannot keep sacrificing our land and planet for these companies' short-term profits.
