I urge you strongly to rule against running a fracked gas pipeline through rural Hamilton. In this time of climate emergency, it makes no sense to consider whether to approve this kind of infrastructure, based on continuing and expanding a technology that has already caused so much damage to the environment. to consider it without discussing the impact it will have on the environment in view of the emergency declared in 2018, 2019 and again in 2020 seems negligent of due diligence.
