I am definitely against the proposed pipeline. I am opposed to furthering the expansion of fossil fuel use in any way, shape, or form. This particular proposal is very unsettling because of the route that is being proposed. I have yet to see any guarantees that damage from leakage from a pipeline will be 100% covered by producers and/or pipeline operators. If such a guarantee were forthcoming together with the potential billions of dollars of clean-up costs being held by a third party I would still have a problem. The route is going through a greenbelt that we need to have protected for so many reasons, one of which is climate integrity. This pipeline flies in the face of international recognition that climate and winding down fossil fuel consumption go hand-in-hand.
