We are writing to you to express our concern re the application by Enbridge Gas Inc to expand its natural gas pipeline as per the above application.

We are very worried about the effects to our natural environment if such an expansion is allowed to be approved. Such negative effects, as would take place if the application is approved would have a profound impact on our environment for generations to come and do nothing to address the climate crisis we are encountering. Such a pipeline could increase greenhouse gas pollution, especially as it is extracted by fracking.

We should be investing in research to improve and find new sources of green energy as we are in a climate emergency.

The fossil fuel industry needs to work to help the environment, not harm it. These companies need to work with the environment not against it.

We feel the OEB should hold fully transparent oral hearings so that all information and submissions can be heard from all citizens.

The land in which this pipeline must go through is environmentally very sensitive and is protected by the Hamilton Conservation Authority. Such an approval of an application would appear to fly in the face of years of efforts to protect our environment.
