INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Shell Energy North America (Canada) Inc. (Shell) filed an application on February 25, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity retailer licence ER-2014-0383.

The licence was issued to the applicant on March 12, 2015 and is set to expire on March 11, 2020. The licence provides that the term may be extended by the OEB.

On March 9, 2020, Shell filed a letter requesting an extension to the term of the licence, pending the final determination of its renewal application.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, it has been found appropriate to issue an order extending the term of the licence ER-2014-0383 until such time as the renewal application is determined on a final basis. This Decision & Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of Shell Energy North America (Canada) Inc.'s licence ER-2014-0383 is extended until May 15, 2020, or until the final determination of the electricity retailer licence application, whichever is earlier.
