Re: Utility Remuneration and Responding to Distributed Energy Resources

Following its February 20, 2020 stakeholder meeting, the OEB invited stakeholders to provide written comments on OEB staff's preliminary proposals for the scope of each initiative. The OEB's January 21, 2020 invitation letter indicated written comments would be due on March 20, 2020. On March 9, 2020 the Electricity Distributors Association filed a letter requesting an extension to March 27, 2020, which the OEB granted.

In light of the unprecedented circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic and the impact on utilities' immediate business priorities and human resources, the EDA has requested a further extension on the deadline for written comments. The OEB has decided to grant a one month extension.

The new deadline for written comments is April 30, 2020. Comments should be filed in accordance with the instructions set out in Attachment A.

Any stakeholders who have already filed written comments are welcome to resubmit by the new deadline, should they wish to take advantage of the additional time available to them.
