## **Background**

On July 25, 2019, the OEB initiated a consultation to review Enbridge Gas Inc.'s fiveyear gas supply plans in keeping with the gas supply plan assessment process contemplated in the OEB's <u>Report of the Board: Framework for the Assessment of</u> <u>Distributor Gas Supply Plans</u> (Gas Supply Framework)<sup>1</sup>.

In the July 25, 2019 letter, the OEB indicated that cost awards would be recovered from all rate-regulated natural gas distributors based on their respective customer numbers. Also, in that letter, the OEB outlined five activities eligible for cost awards. The OEB determined the eligible number of hours for three activities. The OEB stated that the eligible number of hours for the remaining activities would be determined at a later date.

On August 26, 2019, the OEB issued its Decision on Cost Eligibility granting cost eligibility to twelve parties. In its Decision, the OEB noted that there were stakeholders with overlapping interests. The OEB indicated its expectation that stakeholders with similar viewpoints would coordinate their activities in order to increase efficiency and minimize costs.

On September 27, 2019, the OEB determined the eligible number of hours for written comments on Enbridge's five-year gas supply plans (which was one of the five eligible activities for cost awards outlined in the July 25, 2019 letter). On December 19, 2019, the OEB also determined the eligible number of hours for written comments on the draft OEB Staff Report.

For the stakeholder conference that took place on September 23-24, 2019, the eligible hours are 11.5 hours (7.5 hours on September 23, 2019 and 4 hours on September 24, 2019).

The list of activities for which cost claims may be filed and the maximum number of hours are outlined in Appendix A.

## **Notice of Hearing**

The OEB is initiating this hearing on its own motion in order to determine the cost awards that will be made in accordance with section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 in relation to eligible consultation activities that have occurred since July 25, 2019.

The OEB intends to proceed by way of written hearing unless a party can satisfy the OEB that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If a party wants to object to a written hearing, the objection must be received by the OEB no later than **seven (7) days** after the date of this Notice.

Assuming that the OEB does not receive any objections to a written hearing, the hearing will follow the process set out below.

1. Eligible persons shall submit their cost claims by **April 21, 2020.** The cost claim must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served on each rate-regulated natural gas distributor. The cost claims must be completed in accordance with section 10 of the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

# Eligible persons must use the customized Cost Claim Form attached as Appendix B to this Notice.

- 2. Natural gas distributors will have until **May 7, 2020** to object to any aspect of the costs claimed. The objection must be filed with the OEB and one copy must be served on the eligible person against whose claim the objection is being made.
- 3. An eligible person whose cost claim was objected to will have until May 21, 2020 to make a reply submission as to why its cost claim should be allowed. A copy of the reply submission must be filed with the OEB and one copy is to be served on the objecting natural gas distributor.
- 4. The OEB will then issue its decision on cost awards. The OEB's costs may also

be addressed in the cost awards decision.

Service of cost claims, objections and reply submissions on other parties may be effected by courier, registered mail, facsimile or e-mail.

The OEB will use the process set out in section 12 of its *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* to implement the payment of the cost awards. Therefore, the OEB will act as a clearing house for all payments of cost awards in this process. For more information on this process parties may refer to the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* and the October 27, 2005 letter regarding the rationale for the OEB acting as a clearing house for the cost award payments. These documents can be found on the OEB's <u>Rules</u>, Codes, Guidelines and Forms webpage.

All materials filed with the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2019-0137**, be made in a searchable/unrestricted PDF format and sent electronically through the OEB's web portal at <a href="https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice">https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice</a>. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and email address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <a href="https://www.oeb.ca/industry">https://www.oeb.ca/industry</a>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below.

NOTE: The OEB is temporarily waiving the paper copy filing requirement until further notice. All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.

If you do not file a letter objecting to a written hearing or do not participate in the hearing by filing written materials in accordance with this Notice, the OEB may proceed without your participation and you will not be entitled to further notice in this proceeding.
