I would like to express serious concern about the blasting which will be necessary to put the fracked gas line in the proposed area. During the construction of Antrim Glen, a lot of blasting had to be done and each home was inspected before that started. There were a lot fewer homes at that time than the 298 homes that comprise Antrim Glen today. So I am very concerned that there may be damage to my home not to mention the truck traffic. We have no sidewalks

and not everyone can walk fast or get out of the way quickly.

Secondly I do not want any forest to be cleared, we need all the trees we can get!

Given that there is so much opposition to the pipelines, Canada needs to get its resources to BC and to the southern US, why on earth would we be allowing this project to go ahead to deliver gas fracked in Pennsylvania to be sent to the US Eastern Seaboard. That is just plain disgusting and totally unacceptable. Let the US take care of it themselves and stop hurting our environment!

There are other options for Enbridge as I understand it and, even though I am sure that it would be more expensive, inconvenient or whatever, 400 homes should not be affected by this choice. We are all adults who sought the quiet and solitude of the country to spend the latter part of our life and it should be respected as should our environment and farming community.
