RE: EB-2020-0066 Enbridge Gas Inc.- Voluntary Renewable Natural Gas Program Energy Probe Intervenor Request Letter

Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) applies for intervenor status in the EB-2020-0066 proceeding, the application by Enbridge Gas Inc. to the Ontario Energy Board for approval of its Voluntary Renewable Natural Gas Program.

Statement of Interest

Energy Probe is an environmental and consumer organization which promotes economic efficiency in the use of resources. Energy Probe will be representing its natural gas residential and small commercial customer supporters in Ontario, which we have some number of thousands. Energy Probe's supporters will be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding through rate impacts on residential and small commercial customers. In order to protect the interests of its supporters, Energy Probe will focus on the following three concerns that it hopes will be dealt with in this proceeding.

- 1. Does Enbridge's program meet the requirements of the EB-2011-0242/0283 Decision?
- 2. Enbridge's evaluation of three voluntary RNG programs and its selection of the proposed program.
- 3. Enbridge's ten year forecast of program revenues and costs including the results of market research.
