Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project – Update on Stage 2 Archaeological

Assessments

Dear Ms. Long:

Enbridge Gas is writing to inform the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") that topsoil stripping occurred on two small separate parcels of land located in the Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project area following a Stage 2 Archaeological Assessment ("AA") prior to receiving written clearance from the Ministry of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries ("MHSTCI").

Enbridge Gas can confirm that no artifacts were found during the Archaeological Assessments completed on the Project to date. However, to ensure the process outlined in its March 26, 2020 letter to the OEB is followed as the Project moves forward, Enbridge Gas has implemented the following measures:

- suspending all further work at the two properties noted above;
- ii) all sites in the Project area that have not received archaeological clearance from the MHSTCI have been fenced and marked clearly with "No Access" signs; and
- iii) guidelines have been shared with the construction team that more clearly identifies "Go" and "No Go" areas.

Enbridge Gas has also notified the MHSTCI in writing. As part of this notification Enbridge Gas identified the measures listed above.
