## Re: E.L.K. Energy Inc. EB-2019-0029 Application for 2020 Rates

The OEB issued a Decision and Rate Order on the incentive rate-setting mechanism (IRM) application filed by E.L.K. Energy Inc., in the above-noted proceeding, on April 16, 2020.

The Decision and Rate Order was accompanied by a Rate Generator Model. Following issuance of the Decision and Rate Order, the OEB learned of an inadvertent input error in the "bill impacts" worksheet of the Rate Generator Model. Specifically, a charge of \$0.0045 per kWh related to the item "Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment (2016) - Applicable only for Non-RPP Customers - effective until April 30, 2022" was mistakenly included in the bill impact calculation for a residential customer consuming 750 kWh. The bill impact calculation was then referred to in the Introduction and Summary section of the Decision and Rate Order.

Pursuant to Rule 41.02 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, the OEB may at any time, without notice or a hearing of any kind, correct a typographical error, error of calculation or similar error made in its orders or decisions. The OEB considers this to be an error of calculation.

Today, the OEB is reissuing the Decision and Rate Order with the error corrected. The correction can be found at paragraph 5 of page 1 of the Decision and Rate Order, a copy of which is attached.

Paragraph 5 now reads:

As a result of the OEB's findings in this Decision, there will be a monthly total bill decrease of \$0.45 before taxes and the Ontario Electricity Rebate for a residential customer consuming 750 kWh, effective May 1, 2020.

The Decision and Rate Order, as originally issued, stated:

As a result of the OEB's findings in this Decision, there will be a monthly total bill increase of \$2.92 before taxes and the Ontario Electricity Rebate for a residential customer consuming 750 kWh, effective May 1, 2020.

The Decision and Rate Order is not otherwise changed in any way.
