Important Information About Your Rates July 2007 Rate M2 – Commercial/Industrial Direct Purchase

The Ontario Energy Board has approved changes to the rates Union Gas charges its customers effective July 1, 2007. For most Commercial/Industrial customers the total decrease will amount to \$ 0.18 per year based on an annual volume of 17,000 m³. The enclosed bill uses the new rates.

Transportation

The transportation rate has decreased by 0.0449 cents/m³ to 3.5830 cents/m³. For most customers the decrease will amount to \$7.64 per year depending on the amount of natural gas used. The new rate appears in the **"Transportation to Union Gas"** line on your bill.

Delivery

The new rates also reflect an increase of 0.0439 cents/m³ in the Delivery Price Adjustment. For most customers the increase will amount to \$7.46 per year depending on how much gas is used. You will see the new rate in the "**Delivery Price Adjustment**" line on your bill.
