**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (“Enbridge Gas”)  
2021 Dawn Parkway Expansion Project (EB-2019-0159)**

We are legal counsel to Enbridge Gas in this matter.

On March 17, 2020 the Government of Ontario declared an emergency in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic which is unprecedented in its scope and of an uncertain duration and economic impact. As a result, Enbridge Gas respectfully requests that the OEB temporarily adjourn the proceeding until there is greater clarity as to any impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the project. As a condition of the adjournment, Enbridge Gas proposes to report to the OEB as soon as reasonably possible and certainly within six (6) months of the date of the adjournment as to whether Enbridge Gas has sufficient clarity to proceed with the application as filed, including responses to the interrogatories already asked and any further interrogatories arising from any updated evidence. In the interim, Enbridge Gas is continuing to work with First Nations and affected stakeholders including the City of Hamilton, landowners and permitting agencies to advance the project.

Enbridge Gas recognizes that costs may have been incurred by those intervenors eligible for costs and leaves it to the OEB’s discretion as to whether any interim cost awards should be made as part of the adjournment.
