The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) is in receipt of the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB) Notice of Hearing of Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.'s Integrated Resource Planning (IRP) proposal, and is writing to request intervenor status.

The IESO is responsible for maintaining and administering the Ontario wholesale electricity markets, and directing the operation and maintaining reliability of the IESO-controlled grid. The IESO also has the mandate to ensure the adequacy and efficiency of electricity supply in the province through planning of electricity supply and forecasting demand. It directs the operation of generation and transmission facilities, including interconnection facilities that are situated in Ontario.
