DECISION AND ORDER

SESCO Enterprises Canada Ltd. filed an application on March 3, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant has been previously licensed by the OEB, however it did not renew its electricity wholesaler licence and has been operating without a licence since May 21, 2019. Thus, the applicant has contravened section 57 of the OEB Act, and may be subject to an OEB compliance action.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity wholesaler licence to SESCO Enterprises Canada Ltd. This licence is granted without prejudice with regard to any future compliance actions.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
