Re: EB-2018-0242 – Hydro One Peterborough MAADs – SEC Cost Claim

We are counsel to the School Energy Coalition ("SEC"). Enclosed, please find SEC's cost claim in this matter on the Board's form with accompanying detailed dockets.

In this proceeding Hydro One sought approval to acquire Peterborough Distribution. The proceeding included extensive interrogatories, a technical conference, and a two day oral hearing, followed by written argument. From the technical conference until the end, this proceeding was combined with EB-2018-0270, the acquisition by Hydro One of Orillia Hydro, which had similar facts and a similar rate proposal.

Senior Counsel Jay Shepherd took the lead, and time spent by co-counsel Mark Rubenstein has not been claimed.

Because the technical conference, oral hearing and argument were essentially combined, SEC has for the most part simply divided the time spent equally between the two cases for those phases. We estimate that this is a fair division between the two cases. In the few cases where that was not the case, we have allocated time spent based on the specific issues that related to Orillia or Peterborough. Time spent in the interrogatory phase in the Peterborough case, prior to the combination of the cases, is probably lower than it would otherwise have been, perhaps by 10 hours, because of the time spent on the motion in the Orillia case.

Many of the issues that arose in this proceeding, and the companion Orillia proceeding, were unique, and could have far-reaching consequences in distributor consolidation decisions. SEC, as it has done in the past, took the lead on most of those key issues. A considerable amount of time, for example, was required to look in detail at the Hydro One Cost Allocation Model, and make comparisons between the proposals in these proceedings, and past research by Hydro One on cost allocation between its different geographic areas.



Pending guidance from the Board Secretary's office, in the current remote work environment as a result of COVID-19, we have not been able to easily arrange to have the Board's form of affidavit commissioned. Rather, I have provided the recitation below, which includes the same statements that are on the Board's cost claim affidavit, for the purposes of attesting the accuracy of the enclosed cost claim. We hope in the current circumstances that this is acceptable to the Board.

In lieu of a commissioned affidavit, and as a member of the Law Society of Ontario and an Officer of the Ontario Court and, as such, mindful of my duties to the Ontario Energy Board, I, Jay Shepherd, provide this statement confirming that;

1. I am a legal representative of the School Energy Coalition and as such have knowledge of the matters attested to herein.

2. I have examined all of the documentation in support of the attached cost claim, including the attached "Summary of Fees and Disbursements Being Claimed", "Statement(s) of Fees Being Claimed" and "Statement(s) of Disbursements Being Claimed".

3. The attached "Summary of Fees and Disbursements Being Claimed", "Statement(s) of Fees Being Claimed" and "Statement(s) of Disbursements Being Claimed" include only costs incurred and time spent directly for the purposes of the Party's participation in the Ontario Energy Board process referred to above.

4. This cost claim does not include any costs for work done, or time spent, by a person that is an employee or officer of the Party as described in sections 6.05 and 6.09 of the Board's Practice Direction on Cost Awards.
