# **TransAlta Cogeneration Limited Partnership**

Request to Amend Electricity Generation Licence EG-2003-0184

#### **Decision and Order**

TransAlta Cogeneration Limited Partnership (TransAlta) filed an application on March 11, 2020 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (OEB Act) requesting an amendment to its electricity generation licence EG-2003-0184.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The amendment that TransAlta is seeking is the removal of the MCPL Cogeneration Plant from Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence. Schedule 1 of the licence identifies all generation facilities that TransAlta is authorized to own and/or operate. In its application, TransAlta explained that the MCPL Cogeneration Plant was no longer operational and had in fact been disconnected from the bulk electric system in November 2019. TransAlta stated that it was not requesting any other changes to the licence.

The OEB having considered the application grants the amendment to schedule 1 of licence EG-200-0184. All other provisions remain the same.

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

 Electricity generation licence EG-2003-0184 is amended to remove the MCPL Cogeneration Plant from Schedule 1 of the licence. The amended licence is attached to this Decision and Order.
