**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas)
Low Carbon Energy Project – Application for leave to construct and related
approvals
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2019-0294**

On March 31, 2020, Enbridge Gas filed an updated application to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an order granting leave to construct approximately 755 metres of natural gas pipeline, three stations and two network disconnects in the City of Markham. Enbridge Gas has also applied to the OEB under section 97 of the OEB Act for approval of the form of land-use agreements and under section 36 of the OEB Act for approval of a rate rider to compensate affected customers for costs associated with increased gas consumption.

In accordance with Procedural Order No. 1, OEB staff and intervenors filed interrogatories on May 27, 2020. Enbridge Gas' responses to the interrogatories are to be filed by June 8, 2020.

Enbridge Gas filed a letter on June 3, 2020 requesting an extension to the procedural timeline, such that Enbridge Gas would have until June 15, 2020 to provide responses to interrogatories. Enbridge Gas stated that it had received over 240 interrogatories and was making the request due to the unprecedented COVID-19-related working conditions for its employees and the large number of interrogatories to be answered.

The OEB finds Enbridge Gas' request to be reasonable given the circumstances and grants an extension for Enbridge Gas to file its interrogatory responses by **June 15, 2020**.
