**Re: Consultation on Implementing the Process for Enabling Customers to Opt Out of Time-of-Use Pricing Ontario Energy Board File No: EB-2020-0152**

On June 3, 2020 The OEB issued a letter in respect to initiating a consultation to inform the development of amendments to its Standard Supply Service Code and other regulatory instruments as required in order to ensure the timely, efficient and effective implementation of the new opt-out mechanism. Proposed amendments to Codes will be issued for comment by the OEB as set out in the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998.

The OEB noted that given the technical nature of many of the implementation issues, a TOU Customer Choice Working Group will be established. Stakeholders may volunteer to participate on the Working Group. Its composition will be selected by the OEB. Working Group meetings are expected to be scheduled shortly following the initial stakeholder meeting on June 9, 2020.
