I am concerned re the horizontal bore will improve the usefulness of a conventional vertically bored well by 10 times the volume.

Your report to the EB describes this application by Enbridge as a "like for like" installation only.

My claim is it goes beyond bing just a "like for like" in that the use & usefulness of the bore project can increase the volume of gas transferred by at least 10 times as pressures of gas field currently exist..

Therefore as 3 wells r to b replaced with this 1 horizontal well the Enbridge gas volumes can b increased by at least 70% more than the abandoned wells.

By doing so I contend adjacent property owners having storage will b affected by these changes & should b recognized as such & hence compenseable.
