INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

Peninsula Power, LLC filed an application on June 18, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

Peninsula Power, LLC electricity wholesaler licence EW-2015-0188 expired on June 17, 2020. In order to participate in the IESO-administered markets, the applicant requires an electricity wholesaler licence pursuant to section 57 of the OEB Act.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant's need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity wholesaler, the OEB finds it expedient to extend the term of the existing licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. This Decision and Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The term of Peninsula Power's licence EW-2015-0188 is extended on an interim basis until October 1, 2020, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier. The conditions of licence remain unchanged.
