

**UNDERTAKING J15.8**

**Undertaking**

To provide the estimate of the percentage increase of the energy line of a bill for the typical customer.

**Response**

To provide an estimate of the impact of OPG's proposals on the energy portion of a typical residential consumer's bill, OPG reviewed the information on LDC bills available on the OEB's website at:

For the period beginning May 1, 2008 the average monthly residential bill for all of the LDCs listed in the table is shown as \$112.94. The energy portion of the various bills shown on that table ranges from \$55.10 to \$58.82 per month. The mid-point of this range is approximately \$56.96, or \$59.81 including 5% GST.

Using the Typical Monthly Consumer Bill Impact of \$3.05 in Ex. K1/Tab1/Sch.3/Table 1 and dividing by \$59.81 results in an impact on the energy portion of the bill of 5.10%.
