

The County has reviewed the attached provided letter and still has concerns pertaining to the below:

- 1) **The size of the pipeline** – Understanding there is no loss of capacity to service the existing, can you please confirm what additional capacity was considered for growth in the area and provide details related to the modelled growth and supply confirming the 20 year is met based on the growth plan.
- 2) **The alignment** – The letter did not address why Enbridge now requires the pipeline to be within the County's road allowance, impacting the County's corridor when there is an easement already in place for the majority of the route along CR 46. Please provide clarification and justification on why the new pipeline cannot be installed within the existing easement.
