Re: EB-2020-0091 Enbridge Gas Integrated Resource Planning Pollution Probe Letter - IRP Evidence

Dear Ms. Long:

Procedural Order No. 3 for the above-noted proceeding outlined the process and timing for evidence to be filed by Enbridge, Board Staff and Intervenors. The research outline proposed by OEB Staff appears to cover the full range of issues and Pollution Probe encourages OEB Staff to include all relevant related information that is identifies during the research process. Enbridge identified challenges finding relevant IRP-related information with its initial ICF Report. The more fulsome scope defined by the OEB provides greater clarity and opportunity to expand beyond the limits of the initial assessment. Enbridge indicated that it is commissioning an updated report to provide a more comprehensive review in alignment with the broader scope. It is Pollution Probe's understanding that there will be an opportunity to submit interrogatories on the new evidence filed and that will provide an opportunity to assess residual gaps and ways to mitigate those information gaps, if required.

Pollution Probe is not proposing to develop additional evidence at this time. Should gaps remain following the filing of the reports outlined above, Pollution Probe will assist in helping to fill those gaps as appropriate.
