- a) Please confirm the date Enbridge applied to Essex County for approval to install the proposed NPS 6 pipeline within the County of Essex road allowance.
- b) Please confirm the date Enbridge applied for approval to Essex County to abandon or decommission the existing NPS 10 steel pipeline within the County of Essex road allowance.
- c) Please confirm what date County of Essex was provided the EGI Environmental Report dated July 16, 2019 for the proposed NPS 6 pipeline and provide a copy of the cover letter accompanying the report (if available).
- d) Please confirm the nature of discussions and permit/approvals with Enbridge over the proposed pipeline on or around August 19, 2019 when Enbridge filed its Leave to Construct application to the OEB for approval of the proposed NPS 6 pipeline.
- e) Please confirm the date that Enbridge provided the exact location and depth of cover for its proposed NPS 6 pipeline to the County of Essex.
- f) Please confirm which date Enbridge was notified that County Road 46 would be widened in the future.

- b) Please explain why the County of Essex did not intervene in that proceeding.
