



## Enbridge Gas Inc.

## Application for approval of a System Expansion Surcharge, a Temporary Connection Surcharge and an Hourly Allocation Factor

## PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 3 August 20, 2020

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 8, 2020 under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998,* as amended (OEB Act) for approval of a harmonized System Expansion Surcharge (SES), a Temporary Connection Surcharge (TCS) and an Hourly Allocation Factor (HAF) for the former Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. and Union Gas Limited rate zones.

On June 15, 2020, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1, in which the OEB approved 16 participants as intervenors and established initial procedural steps for parties to file interrogatories and for Enbridge Gas to respond to those interrogatories. Enbridge Gas filed interrogatory responses on July 27, 2020.

On August 17, 2020, Environmental Defence filed a motion requesting that the OEB order Enbridge Gas to provide full and adequate responses to Interrogatories I.ED.2 and I.ED.3.

The OEB will hear this motion in writing.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Environmental Defence shall file any additional submissions or materials regarding its motion with the OEB and serve them on all parties by **August 24**, **2020**.

- 2. OEB staff, Enbridge Gas and intervenors shall file written submissions on the merits of Environmental Defence's motion with the OEB and serve them on all parties by **August 27, 2020**.
- 3. Environmental Defence may file a written reply submission with the OEB and serve it on all parties by **August 31, 2020**.

All materials filed with the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2020-0094**, be submitted in a searchable/unrestricted PDF format with a digital signature through the OEB's web portal at <a href="https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice">https://pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice</a>. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <a href="https://www.oeb.ca/industry">https://www.oeb.ca/industry</a>.
