LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Denomy:

**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc.
NPS 20 Replacement Cherry St. to Bathurst St. Project
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2020-0136**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas Inc.'s (Enbridge Gas) application for approval to replace approximately 4.5 km of 20-inch diameter pipeline on Lake Shore Boulevard from Cherry Street to Bathurst Street and approximately 260 m of 20-inch diameter pipeline on Parliament Street from Mill Street to Lake Shore Boulevard in the City of Toronto (Notice). The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's media agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 and 2 below **prior to September 4, 2020**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at Registrar@oeb.ca.

You are directed:

1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
2. No later than the date the English and French versions of the Notice are posted on Enbridge Gas's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of both versions of the enclosed Notice, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:

- a. All property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
 - b. The clerk of the City of Toronto
 - c. All Indigenous Communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
 - d. The Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto ON M5A 2P9
 - e. All affected utilities and railway companies
 - f. Members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas's office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas's website.
 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter.
 5. To provide a copy of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
