**Re: Enbridge Gas Inc.  
Section 101 Application - Federation of Rental-housing Providers of  
Ontario (FRPO) Motion and correspondence  
Ontario Energy Board File Number: EB-2020-0160**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has reviewed the correspondence filed by Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge) of August 26, 2020 and FRPO of August 27, 2020 concerning the motion filed by FRPO on August 24, 2020.

In Procedural Order No. 2, the OEB set out its expectation that intervenors' participation be strictly limited to the contested issues as set out in Enbridge Gas' application.

The OEB confirms the narrow scope of this proceeding in that it is limited to the depth of pipeline coverage and the abandonment of the existing pipeline, primarily from the public interest considerations of safety, efficiency, and costs. The issues determined in the Decision and Order<sup>1</sup> on the Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project will not be re-considered, except to the extent required if the OEB determines that changes could be required with respect to the depth of cover or abandonment. In particular, the issue of pipeline capacity will not be re-visited in this proceeding.

The OEB requests that FRPO confirm that the motion will be withdrawn.
