**INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER**

General Motors of Canada Company (General Motors) filed an application on August 26, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence EW-2015-0226.

The licence was issued to the applicant on September 3, 2015 and is set to expire on September 2, 2020. The licence provides that the term may be extended by the OEB.

Along with its application, General Motors filed a request for an extension to the term of the licence, pending the final determination of its renewal application.

Considering the time required to process an application in accordance with the OEB's established practice and procedures, it has been found appropriate to issue an order extending the term of the licence EW-2015-0226 to December 31, 2020, or until the renewal application is determined on a final basis. This Decision & Order does not constitute a final decision on the application.

The applicant is reminded that it carries the onus of filing an application in a timely manner considering the OEB's typical timelines for processing licence applications.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

The term of General Motors of Canada Company's licence EW-2015-0226 is extended until December 31, 2020, or until the final determination of the electricity wholesaler licence application, whichever is earlier.
