Re: Essex Powerlines November 1, 2020 Rates (EB-2019-0034)

Dear Ms. Long,

On April 22nd, 2020, Essex Powerlines Corporation ("EPLC") elected to postpone implementation of its May 1, 2020 rates in light of the COVID-19 emergency. By way of this submission, EPLC is seeking Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") approval to implement the rates that were approved under EB-2019-0034 effective November 1, 2020 along with the creation of a Foregone Revenue Rate Rider which is further detailed in the OEB prescribed model that accompanies this correspondence.

EPLC is requesting approval to implement a Foregone Revenue Rate Rider for all rate classes to be collected over the six-month period of November 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021. EPLC is also requesting approval to apply a one-time payment to all applicable microFIT customers that did not receive the reduced monthly service charge during the six-month period of May 1, 2020 to October 31, 2020.

To remain consistent with the disposition periods approved in the Decision and Rate Order dated April 16, 2020, EPLC is also respectfully requesting that the Rate Rider for the Disposition of Lost Revenue Adjustment Mechanism Variance Account be collected over the twelve month period of November 1, 2020 to October 31, 2021 and the Rate Rider for the Disposition of Accounts 1584 & 1586 be collected over the twenty-four month period of November 1, 2020 to October 31, 2022 (changes to the effective dates are reflected in the Tariff of Rates and Charges included with this submission).
